## 2013 Photo Essay Contest

### Rules and Regulations

1. Contest entries must include a completed entry form and photos can be in colour or black and white. The essay or poem should describe your photo, where and when it was taken, and the feelings and memories of Pinery that it evokes in approximately 100 words. For online entries, photos must be in a high quality jpeg format, minimum resolution of 300 pixels per inch and at least 4 x 6 inches (1200 x 1800 pixels). For mail in entries, photos should be unmounted, packaged with cardboard stiffeners and submitted on photo-quality paper. A separate entry form must be included with each mail-in entry and mailed to: The Friends of Pinery Park, PO Box 40, Grand Bend ON, N0M 1T0. All entries and contest materials received become property of The Friends of Pinery Park and will not be returned.
2. There is no limit to the number of entries per person. Each submission must include a separate entry form. You may enter as many times as you like online but only one photo may be submitted with each online entry form.
3. In the event the photo is a winner, any models that are in your photograph must be named and a model release form must be signed.
4. To be considered in the contest, all submissions must be original photographs taken of or in Pinery Provincial Park.
5. The photo contest deadline has been extended until midnight of February 28th 2014 for the submission of photos in the Winter in Pinery category only. Entries in the other categories will be accepted until midnight of November 30th 2013.
6. The photographer's name will be credited if chosen for the Pinery memories book. The Friends of Pinery Park will credit the photographer's name, whenever possible, in the event the photo is used in other publications or displays. The use of a photo in a publication may include, but is not limited to, publications that may be published for sale (e.g. Postcards). The Friends of Pinery Park are not required to compensate or reward individuals for the use of their photos.
7. *Eligibility:* The Friends of Pinery Park Photo Contest is open to any amateur photographer who visits Pinery Provincial Park.
8. Only the photographer has the right to submit a photo, and the photographer must sign each entry form in compliance with the rules of the contest.
9. By signing the entry form or checking the "*I agree to the above terms*" box on the online form, the participant consents to entry of his/her submission and agrees to the Rules and Regulations of the contest, as well as the decisions of the judges, which are final and binding in all matters pertaining to this contest. The online entry form cannot be submitted until the "*I agree to the above terms*" box is checked.
